



## International Global Grants 2018-2019

### Global Grants:

- Global Grants may be submitted anytime during the Rotary Year. There is no deadline for submission.
- Clubs are urged to email [pete.doragh@doraghlawfirm.com](mailto:pete.doragh@doraghlawfirm.com) regarding any proposed grants requesting District Designated Funds (DDF) for review prior to submitting the grant to TRF.
- Jeff Fusco will provide sign off on the grant application to DG Sandra Hemstead and District TRF Chair Pete Doragh for their authorization of District Designated Funds.
- In order to qualify for District Designated Funds, clubs participating in the grant will submit the club donation, payable to The Rotary Foundation APF to Jeff Fusco (and not directly to TRF).
- The APF donation will be replaced 1:1 with District Designated Funds, up to \$15,000 maximum per grant/project, and \$30,000.00 per club, until funds are exhausted for the year.
- Clubs that participate beyond the maximum DDF match must submit club cash to the grant project rather than APF.
- Each club may lead no more than two individual Global Grants that includes matching DDF from 6960.
- Each club which leads a Global Grant agrees to provide photographs of the project implementation & results to DRFC, Pete Doragh for publicity.

### Minimum Criteria for Club Eligibility

- The Club must be certified for the 2018-19 year by at least one grant leader attending a District lead Grant Management seminar by June 2018.
- The Club must give the District TRF Chair Pete Doragh a Club MOU, as modified for District 6960 for the 2018-19 year by May 31, 2018.
- Club dues to the District and Rotary International and Semi-Annual reports must have been filed by August 31, 2017 and February 28, 2018 respectively.
- No Global Grant or District Grant paperwork due from the Club shall be past its due date at the time a grant application is approved.
- Club must achieve TRF APF (share) contributions in 2017-18 of at least \$100 per member using the RI club membership as of July 1, 2017.
- Club President Elect (President 2017-18) attended PETS or a substitute Training approved by the District Governor.
